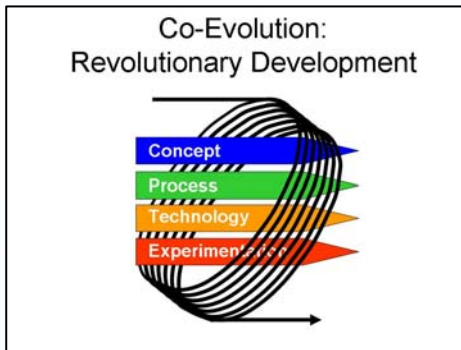

Joint Expeditionary Employable Effects (J3E): Concept Development and Experimentation

J3E is a concept for the identification, projection, employment, and sustainment of modular, reconfigurable force capabilities across the full range of military operations. J3E integrates intelligence, operations, and logistics functions to enable an adaptive, network-centric command and control structure and planning process for the U.S. Joint Forces. J3E is supported by a collaborative adaptive planning and decision support toolset, which uses cutting-edge information technology practices and components to deliver decision-quality information to the warfighter. ICF developed J3E in accordance with tasking from the Joint Deployment Process Owner, USJFCOM, to assist in the development of an integrated Joint Force Projection (JFP) Enterprise to enhance the warfighter's visibility and influence in aligning and synchronizing JFP requirements, sourcing, projection, and integration of force capabilities.

Sense and Respond Logistics (S&RL)

ICF developed the S&RL concept for the Office of the Secretary of Defense, Office of Force Transformation (OFT). S&RL is a logistics system for network-centric operations based around highly adaptive, self-synchronizing units that are potential consumers and providers of logistics support to and from all other units or elements in the network. This network dynamically synchronizes to respond to changes in the operational environment—especially commander's intent—to ensure logistics demands are efficiently satisfied throughout the operations space.

The S&RL initiative was key to catalyzing change throughout DoD towards evolving a distributed, adaptive logistics capability. Consistent with the OFT's strategy, ICF managed the co-evolution of the S&RL concept, processes, system design, technology, IT prototype, and organizational design in rapid spiral feedback loops that emphasized analysis, experimentation, and operational validation opportunities.
