Waivers. Limitation of Liability. In no event shall ICF be liable for any indirect, incidental, special or consequential damages whatsoever (including but not limited to lost profits or interruption of business) arising out of or related to the documents or services provided under this Agreement, even if advised of the possibility of such damages. In no event shall ICF's liability in connection with this Agreement exceed the amounts paid to ICF hereunder.

Proprietary And Trade Secret Information/Usage Restrictions. Customer agrees that the ICF documents constitute and contain valuable trade secret information of ICF. Customer's disclosure of any information contained therein to anyone other than employees of the Customer is prohibited unless authorised in writing by ICF. Customer will take all necessary precautions to prevent the ICF documents from being available to unauthorised persons. Liquidated Damages. Indemnity. Customer shall indemnify and hold ICF harmless against any liability arising from or related to ICF documents that have been changed without ICF's written approval or have been used for a purpose other than as defined hereunder.
